

### Purchasing a animal

You will need to come to the sale and register as a bidder. You can enter a bid amount on the animal of your choice. You will have the opportunity to talk with the kids prior to the sale to find out how they raised the animal, how it was cared for and what type of feed it was fed.

Cost to you:

Type of Animal	Approx. Weight	Sale price/lb	Total Cost
Beef	1225 lbs	\$2.00/ lb	\$2450
Approx lbs of meat you will get 735# at a cost of \$3.33 /lb plus cut/wrap			
Pork	250 lbs	\$2.00	\$500
Approx lbs of meat you will get 175# at a cost of 2.85/ lb plus cut/wrap			
Lamb	110 lbs	\$2.90	\$319
Approx lbs of meat you will get 55# at a cost of 5.80/ lb plus cut and wrap			
Goat	70 lbs	\$3.30	\$231
Approx. lbs of meat you will get 42# at a cost of \$5.50 plus cut and wrap			

You can also come and support the kids by adding on any donation that you would like. They will use the funds to pay for the cost of raising the animal and many kids will start their college funds with the money they earn.
